Jeff Vowell: History of Forestry Regulations. Jeff is recognized nationally as a leader in forest hydrology and Best Management Practices. His 30-year career with the Florida Forest Service culminated with his position as Assistant Director. Jeff will provide a wellinformed overiew of the history of forestry regulations.



Tammy Cushing: Succession Planning. Tammy is an Extension Forest Business Specialist at the University of Florida. She will help navigate the important process of succession planning, which is crucial for both small family-owned businesses and large corporations. Learn the steps to ensure the successful continuity of critical roles within your company or organization.





Tom Hoctor & Ernie Shae: Florida Climate Smart **Agriculture Initiative.** Tom & Ernie will discuss climate smart agriculture solution pathways & ecosystem services that benefit the public, producers & the planet. They will highlight needed conservation policies & priorities.



Joe Conrad: Current Status and Challenges Facing Logging **Businesses.** Joe is associate professor of forest operations in the Harley Langdale Jr. Center for Forest Business at the University of Georgia.
